Class 1– Keelboats: 2 Solings –3- Fast Handicap Dinghies, 4- Slow Handicap Dinghies and dinghies with a Junior helm. Dinghy handicaps will be set as in the current PY handicap list but Club Dinghies will be sailed with the adjusted PY handicap.. Keelboat h'caps will be set using CYCA. Boats sailing without spinnakers or with non standard rigs will be given an appropriate handicap. Depending on numbers taking part classes may be given a combined or a separate start.

The race organisers shall not be responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury howsoever caused to the owner/ person in charge or crew, as a result of their taking part in the event. Moreover every owner/ person in charge warrants the suitability of the boat for the race or races. I confirm that boat entered above has valid insurance cover including an amount of at least £1,000,000 for third party risks.
